If you want to stick to the dozens of free books available, click the one you like the most, and it will appear in a pop-up window. Once you do, you can start reading. On FunBrain you'll find a selection of books for elementary and middle grades, including some of the popular books and series that kids like most. Look for titles like Judy Moody, Diary of a Wimpy Kid, Smashie McPerter, Amelia, Stink and more. Each title gives a suggested grade level range.
